How to get there:

By Car: Driving south on I-880, exit at the 23rd / 29th Avenue exit. When you get off the freeway, you will be on Kennedy Street. Stay on Kennedy Street through the stoplight; then it curves to the left, then it curves to the right and you'll be suddenly on the Park Street Bridge going onto the island of Alameda! Turn right at the second stop light that is Clement. Go through the stop sign (Oak Street) and then about a mile down until you see Alameda Marina on your right. Look for Gate 7 of the Marina on your right opposite Schiller Street. Turn into that gate. Follow the "Island Yacht Club" signs, and you are here!
